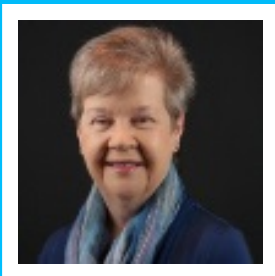


GET MORE CLIENTS

BY LOCATING EXPERT WITNESSES



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Expert Witness Resume Review

1. Is this a CV or a resume?
2. Does the document contain the basic contact information: Address, email, phone?
3. Does the document list work experience with accomplishments?
4. Does the author list education and work experience in reverse chronological order? (Most recent, ending with least recent?)
5. Does this person have current clinical experience related to case in question?
6. If not, when was the last time the expert worked in that clinical area?
7. What is your assessment of the resume design? (Easy to read, uncluttered versus crowded?)
8. Did the expert use a standard font? Is the size readable?
9. Is the format consistent?
10. Does the document contain any of the items to be excluded? (Objective, pictures, personal information, personal references, stuffing, uncommon abbreviations, typographical or grammatical errors, inappropriate email address, statements that she is an expert, list of clients or cases)
11. Does this document convey the expert's expertise?
